AN ACT CONCERNING BILLING AGENT LICENSES FOR SHARED ENERGY MERCHANT FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 277 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to initiate a docket to develop a
- 3 process for issuing billing agent licenses to electric suppliers, and to
- 4 permit such electric suppliers to own and operate shared energy
- 5 merchant facilities for purposes of allocating billing credits to electric
- 6 distribution company customers.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to initiate a docket to develop a process for issuing billing agent licenses to electric suppliers and to permit such electric suppliers to own and operate shared energy merchant facilities.
