AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM FOR THE TEACHING OF CERTAIN IMPORTANT LIFE SKILLS TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a pilot program in
2 five school districts for the school year commencing July 1, 2021, that
3 requires that each high school student in such school districts to
4 successfully complete a one-semester course that contains a curriculum
5 that focuses on (1) social good, (2) emotional learning and life skills, (3)
6 active listening, (4) problem solving, (5) anger management, (6) mental
7 health, (7) conflict resolution, and (8) financial literacy and personal
8 finance basics taught in collaboration with a licensed social worker,
9 licensed financial planner, certified accountant, certified insurance
10 producer or other certified financial professional.

To better prepare our high school students for issues they may face as adults.
