**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A PEDESTRIAN ISLAND ON WHALLEY AVENUE IN NEW HAVEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 \_\_\_\_ dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of
- 5 Transportation for the purpose of providing a grant-in-aid to the city of
- 6 New Haven to construct a pedestrian island on Whalley Avenue near
- 7 the intersection with Davis Street.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide funds to the city of New Haven to reduce injury and promote safety and walkability on a widened area of Whalley Avenue where two pedestrians have been killed by motor vehicles.
