**AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSPORTATION OF POLICE DOGS BY
AMBULANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow an ambulance to
- 2 transport a police dog injured in the line of duty and in need of
- 3 emergency medical care to a veterinary clinic or similar facility if there
- 4 are no individuals in need of transportation or emergency assistance,
- 5 provided a police officer may be required to accompany the dog during
- 6 transportation.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for the safety and well-being of police dogs by allowing an ambulance to transport a police dog injured in the line of duty and in need of emergency medical care to a veterinary clinic or similar facility if there are no individuals in need of transportation or emergency assistance.
