**AN ACT CONCERNING STATE PALLIATIVE MARIJUANA PROGRAM
RECIPROCITY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Consumer Protection to establish a program allowing visitors with out-
- 3 of-state prescriptions for the palliative use of marijuana to purchase
- 4 marijuana from state dispensaries of palliative marijuana.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Consumer Protection to establish a program allowing visitors with out-of-state prescriptions for the palliative use of marijuana to purchase marijuana from state dispensaries of palliative marijuana.
