AN ACT CONCERNING AGRICULTURAL FAIRS AND STATE POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-5 of the general statutes be amended to limit the
- 2 reimbursement rate that a town or an organization that sponsors an
- 3 agricultural fair in a town with resident state troopers pays state police
- 4 officers who provide on-site security for the fair and traffic control on
- 5 public roads during such fair to eighty-five per cent of the cost of
- 6 compensation, maintenance and other expenses of such officers.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the reimbursement rate for state police officers providing on-site security and traffic control related to agricultural fairs in towns with resident state troopers.
