***AN ACT PROHIBITING THE REFERRAL OF STUDENTS WITH
INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS ENROLLED AT
TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND CAREER SCHOOLS TO THEIR HOME
SCHOOL DISTRICTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 10-76q of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to repeal the provision that permits a technical education and
- 3 career school to refer a student who requires special education to the
- 4 board of education in the town in which such student resides for the
- 5 development of an individualized educational program and that
- 6 requires such board of education to be responsible for the
- 7 implementation and financing of such individualized educational
- 8 program.

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal the provision permitting the referral of a special education student enrolled in a technical education and career school to the school district in which such student resides.
