AN ACT REQUIRING FIFTY-YEAR PROJECTIONS FOR CLIMATE CHANGE LEGISLATION AND COST ASSESSMENTS FOR RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the inclusion of a
- 2 fifty-year projection of how much global warming will be reduced and
- 3 what the cost to each resident of the state is for any legislation designed
- 4 to combat climate change.

Statement of Purpose:

To raise awareness of the cost-benefit analysis of climate change legislation and limit costs to residents of the state when there is an insignificant reduction in global warming from such legislation.
