AN ACT CONCERNING A WORK REQUIREMENT FOR RECIPIENTS OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require that able-
- 2 bodied recipients of public assistance, including, but not limited to,
- 3 medical assistance, are required to work or volunteer unless they are
- 4 exempt under federal law.

Statement of Purpose:

To require able-bodied public assistance recipients to work or volunteer to receive benefits unless they are exempt under federal law.
