**AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR
EPINEPHRINE CARTRIDGE INJECTORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to provide that no
- 2 individual or group health insurance policy that is delivered, issued for
- 3 delivery, renewed, amended or continued in this state and provides
- 4 coverage for epinephrine cartridge injectors shall impose any
- 5 coinsurance, copayment, deductible or other out-of-pocket expense for
- 6 such injectors in an amount that exceeds twenty-five dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To cap the out-of-pocket cost for an epinephrine cartridge injector that is covered by an individual or group health insurance policy at twenty-five dollars.
