AN ACT AUTHORIZING REMOTE LEARNING SCHOOL SESSIONS TO COUNT TOWARD THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY SCHOOL DAYS REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-15 of the general statutes be amended to permit a local
- 2 or regional board of education to include remote learning school
- 3 sessions to count toward the requirement of one hundred eighty days of
- 4 actual school sessions during each school year, provided such board
- 5 adopts a policy for what constitutes student attendance during a remote
- 6 learning school session.

Statement of Purpose:

To create uniformity across all school districts as to remote learning sessions, incentivize students to log-in to remote learning and to support public health by not penalizing students who stay home when not feeling well.
