AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize any municipality
2 that does not have a local police department or resident state trooper
3 and any member municipality of a regional school district that does not
4 have a local police department or resident state trooper to employ a
5 school resource officer, provided (1) such officer reports to the state
6 police troop having jurisdiction over the municipality, (2) such officer
7 completes training developed and administered by the Police Officer
8 Standards and Training Council, and (3) costs associated with the
9 employment of such officer shall not be subject to the municipality's
10 minimum budget requirement.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit all municipalities to employ school resource officers.
