AN ACT REQUIRING HOSPITALS TO PROVIDE FAMILIES OF A STILLBORN INFANT A MINIMUM OF TWENTY-FOUR HOURS TO MAKE DECISIONS REGARDING BURIAL OR CREMATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require hospitals to provide
- 2 families of a stillborn infant a minimum of twenty-four hours before
- 3 making decisions regarding burial or cremation of the infant.

Statement of Purpose:

To require hospitals to provide families of a stillborn infant at least twenty-four hours before making decisions regarding burial or cremation. .
