**AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPLICABILITY OF THE EVICTION
PROCESS TO INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
REHABILITATION FACILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow substance use disorder
- 2 rehabilitation facilities to remove individuals living in such facilities
- 3 who violate conditional residential agreements by a majority vote by the
- 4 board of directors of such facility and without having to resort to the
- 5 eviction process.

To allow substance use disorder rehabilitation facilities to remove
individuals living in such facilities who violate conditional residential
agreements without having to resort to the eviction process.
