**AN ACT REMOVING THE HEPATITIS B VACCINE REQUIREMENT
FOR ADMISSION TO DAYCARE, SCHOOL AND CAMP.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to remove the hepatitis B
- 2 vaccine requirement for admission to daycare, school and camp.

Statement of Purpose:

To remove the hepatitis B vaccine requirement for admission to daycare, school and camp due to recent legal findings that there have been zero events of transmissibility from a student at a daycare, school or camp to anyone else.
