AN ACT CONCERNING ICE CREAM TRUCKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require (1) an ice cream truck
- 2 be equipped with safety equipment, including, but not limited to,
- 3 flashing signal lamps, crossing control arms, caution signs, front convex
- 4 mirrors and rear visibility equipment, and (2) a motor vehicle operator
- 5 to stop completely before passing an ice cream truck that is stationary
- 6 and selling ice cream.

Statement of Purpose:

To require ice cream trucks to install safety equipment to (1) increase the visibility of such truck, (2) warn drivers that children may be present, (3) help the ice cream truck driver see around the truck and increase the ice cream truck driver's line of site, and (4) require a motor vehicle operator to stop completely before passing an ice cream truck that is stationary and selling ice cream.
