***AN ACT PERMITTING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO OPT OUT OF THE COMMON CORE STATE STANDARDS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to permit a local or
- 2 regional board of education to opt out of implementing the Common
- 3 Core State Standards and use alternative standards for the purpose of
- 4 developing and implementing the curriculum for the school district.

To allow school districts to opt out of the Common Core State Standards and to choose an alternative standard for its curriculum.
