**AN ACT EXEMPTING THE ADDRESSES OF FAMILY VIOLENCE
VICTIMS FROM DISCLOSURE UNDER THE FREEDOM OF
INFORMATION ACT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 14 of the general statutes be amended to authorize the
- 2 removal of addresses of victims of family violence, as defined in section
- 3 46b-38a of the general statutes, from records subject to disclosure under
- 4 the Freedom of Information Act.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the safety of family violence victims by allowing them to
remove their addresses from publicly available information.
