**AN ACT CONCERNING QUALIFYING CAREGIVERS AND PALLIATIVE
USE OF MARIJUANA REGISTRATION FEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to only require qualifying
- 2 patients issued a written certification for the palliative use of marijuana
- 3 to pay the Department of Consumer Protection registration fee, and to
- 4 waive such fee for qualifying caregivers registered pursuant to chapter
- 5 420f of the general statutes.

To only require qualifying patients issued a written certification for the
palliative use of marijuana to pay the Department of Consumer
Protection registration fee, and to waive such fee for qualifying
caregivers.
