**AN ACT PROHIBITING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION
FROM INQUIRING ABOUT A PROSPECTIVE STUDENT'S CRIMINAL
HISTORY DURING THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit any
- 2 institution of higher education from inquiring about a prospective
- 3 student's criminal history on an application for admission or at any time
- 4 during the admissions process for such student.
