AN ACT CONCERNING CAR THEFT AND BREAK-INS BY JUVENILES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That titles 46b, 53 and 53a of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 strengthen penalties for juveniles adjudicated for repeat auto theft or
- 3 break-in offenses, to strengthen penalties for adults who facilitate such
- 4 actions and to permit such adults to be charged with risk of injury to a
- 5 minor, to allow law enforcement to use the Corrupt Organizations and
- 6 Racketeering Activity Act when investigating crimes relating to auto
- 7 thefts and break-ins and to establish a task force to review the
- 8 effectiveness of current juvenile treatments facilities and programs for
- 9 juveniles adjudicated for auto thefts or break-ins.

Statement of Purpose:

To address the increase in auto theft and break-ins by juveniles.
