**AN ACT CONCERNING LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT ACCREDITATION
AND STANDARDS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-294ee of the general statutes be amended to eliminate
- 2 the requirement that each law enforcement unit obtain and maintain
- 3 accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement
- 4 Agencies, Inc. beginning on January 1, 2025, and permit such units to
- 5 meet either the standards set by the commission or the Police Officer
- 6 Standards and Training Council.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow law enforcement units to comply with accreditation standards in a manner that is cost efficient to municipalities.
