**AN ACT REQUIRING TRAVEL SERVICE BUSINESSES TO OFFER
REFUNDS FOR TRAVEL CANCELLED DUE TO ILLNESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that any entity selling
- 2 travel services in the state offer to state residents full refunds for travel
- 3 cancelled due to illness, including, but not limited to COVID-19. Such
- 4 refunds may be in the form of equal credit with the company offering
- 5 the travel service.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers from losing money on travel-related cancellations due to illness.
