AN ACT PROVIDING FINANCIAL RELIEF TO NONPROFIT CLUBS AND PRIVATE CLUBS FROM INCREASING LIQUOR PERMIT FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 30-22a of the general statutes be amended to: (1)
- 2 Mandate the annual fee for obtaining a cafe liquor permit for any
- 3 organization that is currently holding a nonprofit club liquor permit be
- 4 set at eight hundred fifteen dollars, and (2) to mandate the annual fee
- 5 for obtaining a cafe liquor permit for any organization that is currently
- 6 holding a club liquor permit be set at three hundred dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide financial relief to nonprofit clubs and private clubs from increasing liquor permit fees.
