AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
- 2 Consumer Protection may adopt regulations in accordance with the
- 3 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes to regulate the sale and
- 4 consumption of alcoholic liquor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
