AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY TICK-BORNE ILLNESSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a task force be established to study tick-borne illnesses and the
- 2 discovery, diagnoses and treatment of such illnesses by health care
- 3 providers, including, but not limited to, the ordering of laboratory
- 4 analyses in this state as compared to other states.

Statement of Purpose:

To determine whether tick-borne illnesses are being appropriately discovered, diagnosed and treated.
