**AN ACT ALLOWING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO TRACK
AND TRACE CELLULAR PHONES OF YOUNG ADULTS IN DISTRESS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow law enforcement
- 2 officers the ability to track and trace a cellular telephone of a person
- 3 aged eighteen to twenty years who is dependent upon and residing with
- 4 a parent or guardian, following an investigation involving the parent or
- 5 guardian, that results in a substantial belief that the young adult is in
- 6 distress or danger.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow law enforcement the ability to track and trace a cellular phone
of an eighteen to twenty-year-old who is believed to be in distress or
danger and still living dependently in the home of a parent or guardian.
