AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR CERTAIN PROJECTS ON TRIBAL LANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
4 one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which
5 shall be used by the Department of Energy and Environmental
6 Protection, with one million dollars of said proceeds used for the
7 purpose of construction of a community well, a septic system and a road
8 allowing access to and use of sacred sites on the Eastern Pequot
9 reservation, and two hundred fifty thousand dollars of said proceeds
10 used for construction of a retaining wall to remove overflow waters
11 from a hydro plant near the historical burial grounds of the
12 Schaghticoke Tribal Nation.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for upkeep as required on tribal lands.
