AN ACT ELIMINATING INCOME AND ASSET LIMITS FOR THE MED-CONNECT PROGRAM FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 17b-597 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) eliminate income and asset limits for working persons
- 3 with disabilities to obtain medical assistance, (2) require the
- 4 Commissioner of Social Services to amend the Medicaid state plan to
- 5 eliminate the income and asset limits, and (3) require the commissioner
- 6 to streamline eligibility determinations and enrollment.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand access to medical assistance by working persons with disabilities.
