**AN ACT PROVIDING IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY TO A
PHYSICIAN WHO ACCOMPANIES AND ASSISTS A STATE,
REGIONAL OR MUNICIPAL SWAT TEAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any person
2 licensed to practice medicine and surgery under the provisions of
3 chapter 370 of the general statutes, who, voluntarily and gratuitously
4 and other than in the course of such person's employment or practice,
5 renders emergency medical assistance in connection with the law
6 enforcement duties of a state, regional or municipal special weapons
7 and tactics team, shall not be liable to any person assisted for civil
8 damages for any personal injuries that result from acts or omissions by
9 such physician in rendering emergency medical assistance, which may
10 constitute ordinary negligence.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide immunity from civil liability to a physician who accompanies and assists a state, regional or municipal SWAT team.
