**AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE POLICY AND CRIMES  
COMMITTED BY JUVENILES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to repeal changes made to the
- 2 general statutes by public acts 15-183, 16-147 and 17-2 of the June special
- 3 session, including those which limited the automatic and mandatory
- 4 transfer of serious criminal offenses from juvenile court to adult court;
- 5 those which eliminated the ability to detain serious offenders after
- 6 arrest; and those which raised the age of juvenile prosecution from
- 7 sixteen years of age to eighteen years of age.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reinstate certain juvenile justice policies in place prior to 2015 in order to provide law enforcement additional tools to combat juvenile crime.
