AN ACT EXEMPTING VETERANS FROM PAYMENT OF THE FARES FOR BUS PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2021*) Any person who is a veteran,
2 as defined in section 27-103 of the general statutes, shall be exempt from
3 payment of the lawful charge for state-owned or state-controlled bus
4 public transportation service, provided such person presents to the fare
5 inspector, as defined in section 13b-2 of the general statutes, or the
6 driver of such bus, as applicable, a motor vehicle operator's license or
7 identity card that indicates such person's status as a veteran, in
8 accordance with subsection (e) of section 14-36h of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
