AN ACT CONCERNING FEES FOR CERTIFIED COPIES OF VITAL RECORDS SOUGHT IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOLDIERS, SAILORS AND MARINES FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 7-74 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
3 *1, 2021*):

4 (c) (1) The fee for one certified copy of a certificate of death for any
5 deceased person who was a veteran, as defined in subsection (a) of
6 section 27-103, shall be waived when such copy is requested by a
7 spouse, child or parent of such deceased veteran.

8 (2) The fee for a certified copy of any vital record shall be waived
9 when such copy is requested by a person in connection with an
10 application for aid from the Soldiers, Sailors and Marines Fund, as
11 established under section 27-138.
