**"AN ACT CONCERNING OVERSIGHT AND TRANSPARENCY AT
THE CONNECTICUT PORT AUTHORITY."**

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) On or before October 1, 2021,
4 and quarterly thereafter, the executive director of the Connecticut Port
5 Authority shall submit a report regarding the status of pending and
6 current contracts, small harbor projects and the construction project at
7 the State Pier in the town of New London to the joint standing
8 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
9 relating to transportation, in accordance with the provisions of section
10 11-4a of the general statutes. The Commissioner of Administrative

11 Services and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall
12 jointly review and comment on each such report before such report is
13 submitted to the committee."

14 Strike section 4 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
15 thereof:

16 "Sec. 4. Subsection (o) of section 15-31a of the general statutes is
17 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
18 *passage*):

19 (o) On or before January 1, [2017] 2022, and annually thereafter, the
20 board of directors shall submit [in writing] a report, in accordance with
21 the provisions of section 11-4a, to the Governor [(1)] and the joint
22 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
23 matters relating to transportation. Such report shall include, but need
24 not be limited to: (1) A description of the projects undertaken by the
25 authority in the preceding year; (2) a list of projects which, if undertaken
26 by the state, would support the state's maritime policies and encourage
27 maritime commerce and industry; [(2)] (3) a description of the
28 authority's finances; (4) recommendations for improvements to existing
29 maritime policies, programs and facilities; and [(3) such other
30 recommendations as the board considers appropriate. Copies of such
31 report shall be submitted to the joint standing committee of the General
32 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to transportation, in
33 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a] (5) recommendations
34 for legislation to promote the authority's purpose. The Commissioner of
35 Administrative Services and the Secretary of the Office of Policy and
36 Management shall jointly review and comment on each report before
37 such report is submitted to the Governor and the joint standing
38 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
39 relating to transportation."
