"AN ACT CONCERNING THE COUNTING OF INCARCERATED PERSONS FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS."

1 Strike subsection (d) of section 1 in its entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(d) The Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management shall
4 prepare and publish such information, both adjusted and unadjusted,
5 pursuant to subsection (c) of this section on or before either the first day
6 of July next following the year in which the decennial census of the
7 United States is taken or the thirtieth day after the publication of the
8 redistricting data for this state by the United States Census Bureau in
9 such year, whichever is later, and such adjusted and unadjusted
10 information shall be the basis for determining state assembly and
11 senatorial districts, as well as municipal voting districts. No residence at
12 an unknown geographical location within the state under subdivision
13 (3) of subsection (c) of this section may be used to determine the average

14 population of any set of districts. The secretary shall notify each
15 municipality that the adjusted and unadjusted information shall be used
16 for the purposes of determining municipal voting districts. In no case
17 may the adjusted information be used for the purposes of calculating
18 municipal aid, as defined in section 7-560 of the general statutes."
