"AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS TO CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES BY THE EXCLUSIVE BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE OF A PUBLIC EMPLOYER BARGAINING UNIT."

1 Strike subsections (i) and (j) in their entirety and insert the following
2 in lieu thereof:

3 "(i) A public employer shall honor authorizations from an employee
4 created for the deductions described in subsection (h) of this section in
5 any form that satisfies the requirements of sections 1-266 to 1-286,
6 inclusive, of the general statutes, including, but not limited to, electronic
7 and voice authorizations that meet the requirements of an electronic
8 signature pursuant to said sections. The revocability of an authorization
9 shall be determined by the terms of the authorization.

10 (j) A public employer that provides for the administration of a payroll
11 deduction authorized by an employee for a public employee
12 organization shall: (1) Not later than seven days after receipt of an

13 employee authorization, as described in subsection (i) of this section,
14 notify such public employee organization of such authorization, and (2)
15 apply the change in deductions reflected in the employee's
16 authorization, as described in subsection (i) of this section, to the first
17 pay period commencing after the public employer's receipt of such
18 authorization."
