Explanation

The amendment does not change the fiscal impact of the underlying bill. The amendment alters the composition of the council established by the bill, which does not alter the fiscal impact of the council. Additionally, the amendment requires the sexual misconduct assessment results to be incorporated into an existing relevant annual report, instead of distributed separately, which does not alter the fiscal impact of the bill to the constituent units.
