### ***Explanation***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

This amendment requires the Department of Public Health (DPH) to identify each public and nonpublic school that has reported that less than ninety-five percent of its students have satisfied the immunization requirements. The department must perform outreach to such schools in the form of education for students and their families concerning such immunization requirements and the consequences for not meeting such requirements, and ensure that the appropriate vaccines are readily available for any student who has not satisfied such immunization requirements. This may result in a potentially significant costs to DPH based on the number of schools DPH would have to perform outreach.
