Potential Future Savings

Under the amendment any student or child who was exempt on religious grounds from the immunization requirements of any other state must be exempt in Connecticut.

This is anticipated to impact a small number of children annually and as such it may result in a minimal future savings to the Department of Public Health as the agency may be paying for fewer vaccinations.
