#### Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, the amendment states that the Governor must appoint six temporary deputies to serve in the Office of the Claims Commissioner within the Department of Administrative Services to be paid \$259 per day plus mileage reimbursement (the same rate as a judge trial referee's). This will result in a minimal cost to the Office of the Claims Commissioner within the Department of Administrative Service in both FY 22 and FY 23. (There are no ongoing costs, as the term of the six deputies ends in October 2023.)

Lastly, the strike-all amendment makes other changes that are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact.
