Explanation

The amendment replaces the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, it establishes the Environmental Justice Advisory Council within the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP), stipulating that while Council members cannot be compensated for their service, they can be reimbursed for any actual expenses. Therefore, this may result in a minimal cost to DEEP for reimbursement of Council expenses.

The strike-all amendment makes other changes that are not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities as they would apply to private, third-parties.
