No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language and the fiscal impact in the underlying bill.

The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development shall conduct a study relating to economic development issues affecting distressed municipalities and opportunity zones in the state. Not later than February 1, 2022, the commissioner shall submit a report on the results of such study to the commerce committee.

The amendment establishes a nineteen-member task force to study any impediments to the renovation of historic mixed-use buildings located in municipalities, including, but not limited to, distressed municipalities in the state.

Not later than January 1, 2022, the task force shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the commerce committee.

This amendment has no fiscal impact as PA 17-236 prohibits transportation allowances for task force members.
