The amendment requires the Commissioner of Consumer Protection (DCP) to not use state funds to hire a consultant to make programmatic changes to the licensing system which reduces the cost in the underlying bill. The amendment reduces the cost to DCP by \$40,000 in FY 22 due to not hiring the consultant.
