Explanation

The amendment strikes the language in the original resolution and its associated fiscal impact. The resolution permits several claimants to present their claims to the Claims Commissioner for a hearing not later than a year from passage of this bill. This may result in potential costs to the state related to any future claim award or settlement.
