## **OFA Fiscal Note**

### ***Minimal Cost***

The amendment states that a voting district shall be subject to an audit if the vote for a defeated candidate receiving the next highest number of votes was less than a vote equivalent to one and one-half per cent of the total number of votes cast for the office. This will result in a minimal fiscal impact to conduct the audit.
