### ***Explanation***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. Instead, the amendment provides the following:

The amendment increases, from 15 to 21, the number of members of the Connecticut Port Authority (CPA) board of directors. This results in potential minimal cost to the extent that the additional members are reimbursed for incidental expenses incurred during the performance of official duties, as provided for in CGS Sec. 15-31a.

The amendment also requires the Department of Administrative Services and the Office of Policy and Management to verify various reports provided by the CPA prior to submittal to the General Assembly. This is not expected to have a fiscal impact because this is

The remaining provisions of the amendment are not anticipated to have a fiscal impact.

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
