The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment makes various procedural changes and encourages local and regional school districts to comply with various national and state standards regarding Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning Engineers Standards. The amendment does not require local and regional school districts to make HVAC changes, but if they do so, significant costs could be incurred.

Lastly, the Department of Public Health may incur minimal costs to develop a web-based toolkit for safe environmental health practices for schools and to annually offer a webinar for schools regarding indoor environmental quality topics.
