OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Cost In Bill

The amendment replaces the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to perform a study on the feasibility of establishing and administering a program for the provision of free swimming lessons. This has no fiscal impact as DEEP currently has expertise to conduct the study.
