Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment creates a process for the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) to adjust U.S. Census population data and count inmates at their addresses before incarceration, instead of at their prison address. It also requires the Department of Corrections to report certain demographic information to OPM. This has no fiscal impact, as it is anticipated that both agencies can meet the requirement with existing resources.

As the amendment does not require the adjusted data to be used for determining any grant funding, the amendment has no fiscal impact to municipalities.
