OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Instead, it requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, in conjunction with the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, to study how to enforce statutes and regulations on bodies of water and adjacent roadways covering multiple jurisdictions, including Beach Pond in Voluntown. This has no fiscal impact as both agencies have expertise for this purpose.
